Background

FICCI is organizing a two day conference on 'Methane recovery and utilization in the Indian livestock and agro-industrial sectors' on February 3-4, 2011, New Delhi, India under the aegis of the Global Methane Initiative (GMI). GMI is an international initiative, set up on November 16, 2004, as Methane to Markets (M2M) Partnership and at present has thirty-eight governments including India, the European Commission, the Asian Development Bank and the Inter-American Development Bank. The initiative builds on the existing structure and success of the M2M Partnership to reduce emissions of methane by promoting and facilitating methane recovery and utilization in four sectors - Agriculture, Coal Mines, Landfills and Oil and Gas Systems. This conference focuses on the Indian livestock and agro-industrial sectors.

The conference will bring together policymakers, industry, technology suppliers, project developers, consultants, financial institutions and research organizations to deliberate on methane recovery and utilization potential and opportunities in the Indian livestock and agro-based industrial sectors.
